AWE Donates its ELF Child-Safe Web Browser to Computer Donation Program

Chester, PA – AWE announced today that its ELF Child-Safe Web Browser has been donated for a computer-donation project coordinated by Team Children, a non-profit that refurbishes and distributes personal computers to children, families, and schools at little or no cost.

Team Children is donating 75 computers to children in the preschool and kindergarten classes at Dunbar Elementary School in Philadelphia, PA. The parents of the children will take the computers home with them. In addition, three computers have been placed in both of the preschool classrooms as well as the kindergarten classroom so that teachers can teach the students about the programs.

The first computers will be donated on Friday, November 4, 2011, during the school day with parents in attendance. The computers are pre-loaded with AWE's ELF Child-Safe Web Browser and other donated educational software.

The ELF Child-Safe Web Browser enables children to access over 100 appropriate, educational websites. It provides them with a safe online environment, as the ELF browser blocks access to general search engines and unapproved websites.
